## 2.4 CONFLICT OF INTEREST

2.4.1 In terms of sections 38(3) of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act, Act 16 of 2013, a member of the Municipal Planning Tribunal

- b) may not attend, participate or vote in any proceedings of the Tribunal in relation to any matter in respect of which the member has conflict of interest.

2.4.2 A member has conflict of interest if:

- a) the member, a family member, partner or business associate of the member is the applicant or has a pecuniary or other interest in the matter before the Tribunal;
- b) the member has any other interest that may preclude or reasonably be perceived as precluding the member from performing the functions of the member in a fair, unbiased and proper manner; and
- c) the member is an official in the employment of national, provincial or local government if the department by which such an official is employed, has a direct or substantial interest in the outcome of the matter.
